

Terms and Conditions

Age Restrictions

Fantasy Sports Games Ireland Limited currently holds a Gambling License from the UK Gambling Commission (License Number: 000-038414-R-319758-002). As a condition of the license, only patrons of eighteen years and older may play on Fanfeud. Upon signing up, users must confirm that they are over 18 and that they accept the terms and conditions of Fanfeud. As part of Fanfeud's compliance policy, user may be asked to provide proof of age at various intervals.

Welcome to Fanfeud! This is our step by step guide to help you play our fantasy games and to explain the rules of play.

Once you have signed up and logged in to your Fanfeud account, the screen in front of you is what we call the Dashboard. On the left side of the screen you will see a list of games that are currently available for you to participate in and above them you will have a "recent results" button, which shows the latest games played, the entrants in those games and the subsequent winner. Click on one of the games in the left column to enter into the Gamezone. Once you enter, you will see the available player pool, the current leaderboard and a chat zone with a video explaining the game as well as a button labelled scoring. The button explains the scoring system for the fantasy game.

Gameplay

As stated on our "How to Play" page, please bear in mind the following terms: If two users have selected the same five players, the first entry will be the winner. There are no exceptions to this rule. Entry to games closes 15 minutes before the kickoff of the game. It is not possible to enter teams after this time.

Note, points are not awarded for any players that do not play in the game.

If there is any dispute about the assist provider, goal scorer or any other on field decision/event, we will abide by the decision of our official stat provider. Results are deemed final 12 hours following the end of game, and any retrospective stat changes after that time are not implemented into the scoring for that fantasy game.

Points are not final until stated as such on the website. Some points come in after the game has finished, such as clean sheets and team losses/wins. The entire pot goes to the user appearing at the top of the leaderboard. The winning customer account is then credited with the winning amount.

Results of Games

Fanfeud receives data from statistics provider Infostrada ([http:// www.infostradasports.com](http://www.infostradasports.com)). If any user has an issue with any scoring for any game or any other issues, please report the objection to info@fanfeud.co.uk. Fanfeud will investigate any complaints on the calculation of points totals of any games. The decisions of Fanfeud in respect of any such investigations shall be final.

Withdrawal of Entries

If you would like to withdraw your entry to a game, please email contact@fantasy5live.com to do so. Please note that withdrawals can only be made before 1 hour in advance of kickoff of games. Entries will not be withdrawn after such a time.

Interruptions

If an entry hasn't been recorded due to an interruption, please try to submit an entry again and check if the entry appears on the leaderboard. If again it is not possible to enter a team, please contact us on contact@fantasy5live.com and we will investigate the cause of the interruption. If an interruption has caused a user to enter a team inadvertently, or to enter an incorrect selection, Fanfeud will withdraw the entry. If it is too late to withdraw the entry, Fanfeud will investigate the interruption and if it is deemed that an interruption has caused a mistaken entry, Fanfeud will refund the relevant entry fee.

The promoters of this competition are Fantasy Sports Games Ireland Ltd based in Waterford Road, Kilkenny, Ireland. All disputes will be handled by our dedicated team who will escalate matters to the manager. In the event that we are unable to resolve the dispute and there is a deadlock in place, clients/customers can avail themselves of IBAS, Independent Betting Adjudication Service, who are our third party adjudicators in all disputed matters. All contact with IBAS regarding a dispute is carried out in writing and accordingly an adjudication form must be requested in the first instance.

1. Introduction

1.1 FanFeud recognises that people who use Fanfeud value their privacy. This Privacy Policy details important information regarding the collection, use and disclosure of User information collected on Fanfeud's fantasy sports website located at Fanfeud.co.uk (the "Site") and related mobile app, and any other features, tools, materials, or other services (including co-branded or affiliated services) offered from time to time by Fanfeud (the "Service"). Fanfeud provides this Privacy Policy to help you understand how your personal information is used by us and your choices regarding our use of it.

1.2 This Privacy Policy should be read in conjunction with our [Terms](#). By accessing the Service, you are consenting to the information collection and use practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1.3 Your use of the Service and any personal information you provide through the Service remains subject to the terms of this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use, as each may be updated from time to time.

2. Information We Collect

By using our Service and by submitting personal information to us through your use of our Service then this Privacy Policy will apply. The personal information we collect from you generally may include:

2.1.1 your name;

2.1.2 email address;

2.1.3 date of birth;

2.1.4 username;

2.1.5 submissions to various competitions and promotions;

2.1.6 responses to surveys;

2.1.7 communications sent to us by you;

2.1.8 your subscriptions to newsletters and services offered by us; and

2.1.9 any other information you submit to Fanfeud when choosing to participate in various activities on the Service.

2.1.10 In addition, if you choose to log in, access or otherwise connect to Fanfeud, or contact Fanfeud, through a social networking service (such as Facebook), we may collect your user ID and user name associated with that social networking service, as well as any information you make public using that social networking service. We may also collect information you have authorised the social networking service to share with us (such as your user ID, public profile information, email address, birthday, friends list, and pages you have "liked").

2.2 In addition to the above, we may need to verify your identity in order for you to use some aspects of the Service. For purposes of verification, we may also collect the following personal information from you:

2.2.1 passport information;

2.2.2 driving licence information;

2.2.3 other identification documents;

2.2.4 permanent and temporary address;

2.2.5 other information as may be required to verify you in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

2.3 When you use our mobile app, we also may collect mobile device information like operating system and hardware type, numbers or codes that are unique to your particular device, device information, default device language, the location of your device, and app usage information.

3. The Way Fanfeud Uses Your Personal Information

3.1 We use your personal information to operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of the Service, including but not limited to the following:

3.1.1 providing you with our products and services, including our games;

3.1.2 processing and responding to enquiries;

3.1.3 personalising your use of the Service,

3.1.4 alerting you to new features, special events, products and services, or certain third-party products or services in which we think you will be interested;

3.1.5 enforcing the legal terms that govern your use of the Service; and

3.1.6 investigating and protecting the integrity of Fanfeud's contests.

3.2 We may use your personal information to contact you about:

3.2.1 our products and services in which you may be interested provided that you have not requested otherwise;

3.2.2 newsletters and information for which you have signed up; and

3.2.3 non-marketing or administrative purposes (such as notifying you of major changes to the Service or for customer service purposes).

3.3 We use your information to improve the quality and design of our Service and to create new features, promotions, functionality, and services.

3.4 We may anonymize or aggregate your personal information for business purposes, including for reporting and research. Such anonymized and/or aggregated data does not personally identify you.

4. When Fanfeud Discloses Information

4.1 We may disclose your personal information to our subsidiaries, affiliated companies, agents, businesses, or service providers who process your personal information on our behalf in providing the Service to you. This may include providing customer service, accepting deposits and paying withdrawals, and processing such information to make improvements to the services they provide.

Our agreements with these service providers limit the kinds of information they can use or process and ensure they use reasonable efforts to keep your personal information secure.

4.2 When you choose to share information with social media services about your activities on Fanfeud by, for example, connecting your social media account to our Service, then Fanfeud may share your personal information and information about your use of the Service with such social media sites. Please make sure to read the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy of such sites prior to connecting to our Service in this way.

4.3 In the event that you win a prize we may use your name in connection with publicity purposes.

4.4 When you participate in a contest, we may publish your username on a list of the contest participants.

4.5 Where you have provided your consent, we may share your personal information with selected third parties for their commercial or marketing use in conjunction with your relationship with Fanfeud or as part of a specific program or feature.

4.6 We also may share personal information in other situations with your consent.

4.7 Fanfeud also reserves the right to disclose personal information that Fanfeud believes, in good faith, is appropriate or necessary to enforce our Terms of Use, take precautions against liability or harm, to investigate and respond to third-party claims or allegations, to respond to a court orders or official requests, to protect the security or integrity of our Service, to report violations of Fanfeud's eligibility rules to third parties, including employers of individuals affiliated with other daily fantasy sites, and to protect the rights, property, or safety of Fanfeud, our users or others.

4.8 In the event that Fanfeud is involved in a merger, acquisition, sale, asset sale, insolvency, reorganisation, receivership, assignment for the benefit of creditors, or the application of laws or equitable principles affecting creditors' rights generally, or other change of control, there may be a disclosure of your personal information to another entity related to such event, whereby such entities may carry out certain marketing activities using your information.

5. Your Choices

5.1 Fanfeud will process your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy, and as part of that Fanfeud provides you with certain choices about how we process your personal information. These choices are set out below.

5.2 You can access and update certain personal information Fanfeud holds about you at any time by logging into your account via the Service.

5.3 You can also learn more about and how to control the cookies used by the Service in the cookies section below.

6. Cookies

6.1 Cookies Information: When you visit the Fanfeud.com website, we may send one or more cookies - small files - to your computer or other device, which may enable us or others to uniquely identify your browser. Fanfeud uses both session cookies and persistent cookies. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the site. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser help file directions. Session cookies are temporary and typically disappear after you close your browser. You may be able to reset your web browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is

being sent. However, some features of the Fanfeud.com website may not function properly if the ability to accept cookies is disabled.

6.2 Log File Information: When you use our Service, our servers may automatically record certain information that your device sends whenever you visit any website and use certain apps. These server logs may include information such as your web or app request, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser language, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform type, number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed and the order of those pages, the amount of time spent on particular pages, the date and time of your request, and one or more cookies that may uniquely identify your browser.

6.3 Clear GIFs Information: When you use our Service, we may employ technology such as "clear GIFs" (a.k.a. Web Beacons) which are used to track the online usage patterns of our users. In addition, we may also use clear GIFs in HTML-based emails sent to our users to track which emails are opened by specific users.

6.4 We also use cookies, clear gifs, log file information, and mobile app information for purposes such as (a) remembering information so that you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit our Service; (b) providing custom, personalised content and information; (c) monitoring the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns; (d) monitoring aggregate metrics such as total number of visitors, pages viewed, etc.; and (e) tracking your entries, submissions, and status in promotions, sweepstakes, and contests.

6.5 By using our site you consent to us using the cookies and similar technologies described above.

7. Information Security

7.1 We are committed to protecting the security of your personal information. We use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal information from unauthorised access, use, or disclosure.

7.2 Whilst neither we, nor any other organisation, can guarantee the security of information processed online, we do have appropriate security measures in place to protect your personal information.

7.3 To further protect your privacy and security, we reserve the right to take reasonable steps (such as requesting your password) to verify your identity before granting you profile access or making corrections.

7.4 Additionally, you should ensure your password is kept secret at all times. You will be responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your password and account information.
